We will also have a social program that includes receptions and a guided tour, which will be announced shortly.

Proposal submission

Individual papers and **poster** proposals will include:

1. **Title** (max. 25 words).
2. **Abstract** (max. 750 words including references).
3. **Thematic strand**.
4. **Name, affiliation, email of the presenter(s)** (up to three people).

Papers include 20 min. presentation + 10 min. discussion.

Posters will be printed by the organization as long as they are submitted on time in a specific format (A1 pdf format (59,5 cm x 81,1 cm) no later than May 15, 2025).

Additionally, the conference will accept **thematic panel** proposals including:

1. **Title of the panel**.
2. **Description**: A 750-word abstract (including references) describing the aims, relevance and questions addressed by the panel.
3. **Coordinator(s)** of the panel: Name, affiliation and email (one or two people max.).
4. **Participants** in the panel: Name, affiliation and email. There will be a minimum of three presentations and a maximum of five for a duration of **up to two hours** for the whole panel.
5. **Abstract of the presentations**: Titles and abstracts (max. 300 words) of each presentation included in the panel.

Proposals will be accepted in any of the official languages in Spain or English.

Important deadlines

Proposal submission (individual papers, posters, panels): **no later than October 15, 2024**.

Evaluation of proposals: **November 2024**.

Notification: **December 15, 2024**.

Conference registration: **from January 15 to May 31, 2025**.

Each person may participate in a maximum of two presentations (paper + panel participation; two co-authorships; individual + joint paper, but not two individual papers). A maximum of three people can present a single paper or poster. Each person requires a separate registration. The registration process will be available starting on January 15, 2025.
