



From the organizing committee of the XVI International Conference of General Linguistics (XVI CILG), we are pleased to announce that the University of Alicante will host the next conference from June 11 to 13, 2025. This meeting aims to bring together researchers and professionals in linguistics to share and discuss the latest advances in the field.

The University of Alicante thus follows the trajectory of previous editions, which began in Valencia (1994) and continued in Granada (1996), Salamanca (1998), Cádiz (2000), León (2002), Santiago de Compostela (2004), Barcelona (2006), Madrid (2008), Valladolid (2010), Zaragoza (2012), Pamplona (2014), Alcalá de Henares (2016), Vigo (2018), Seville (2021), and Madrid (2023).

The XVI CILG will feature plenary talks, round tables, thematic panels, oral communications, and posters under any of the following strands:

The languages of the conference will be any of the official languages in Spain and English.

Proposals for **communications and posters** will include:

- **Title** (25 words maximum).
- **Abstract** (maximum of 500 words including bibliography) in the language of the presentation.
- **Strand** to which it is subscribed.
- **Details of the presenters** (maximum of three people): full name, affiliation, email address.

In addition to communications and posters, proposals for **thematic panels** will be accepted, including the following information:

1. **Panel Title:** A clear and concise title reflecting the content of the panel.
2. **Panel Description:** An approximately 500-word summary detailing the objectives, relevance, and specific topics to be addressed in the panel.
3. **Information on the panel coordinator(s):** Name, affiliation, and email address of the panel coordinator (one or two people maximum).
4. **Information on the participants:** full name, affiliation, and email address. The panel will include a minimum of three interventions and a maximum of five, considering that the panel's duration is a **maximum of two hours**, which will be distributed according to the number of contributions included in the panel.
5. **Summaries of the interventions:** titles and summaries (300 words maximum) of each of the presentations included in the panel.

These proposals will be submitted through the platform enabled for this purpose on the congress website.

Important dates:

- Proposal submission period: from July 15 to October 15, 2024.
- Notification of proposal acceptance: December 15, 2024.
- Registration: from January 15, 2025.
- Congress dates: June 11, 12, and 13, 2025.
